

## Comparative Completion & Graduation Rates

In compliance with the Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act (Public Law 101-542, amended by Public Law 102-26), SWCC provides the following completion/ graduation information. Calculation of the Graduation Rate: A student shall be counted as a graduate if, within 150 percent of the normal time for completion of, or graduation from the program, the student has completed or graduated from the program. The graduation rates presented here are based on the number of full-time, first-time (FT/FT) degree- or certificate-seeking students enrolled at SWCC and neighboring community colleges and Virginia Community College System (VCCS) in Fall 2011.
