

TUITION WAIVER FOR SENIOR CITIZENS

Virginia residents who are 60 years of age or over, and who receive less than \$23,850 in annual, taxable income, are permitted to register for credit courses with waiver of tuition and fees. Non-credit courses may be taken, on a tuition and fee-free basis, by senior citizens, regardless of income, if all necessary conditions are met.

This form should be completed by the senior citizen each time he/she registers for courses for which he or she is requesting waiver of tuition.

The **Code of Virginia** provides for Virginia residents (those who have resided in Virginia for one year prior to the beginning of the academic term for which they are enrolling) who are 60 years of age or over to enroll in State supported institutions on a tuition-free basis, provided that their annual, taxable income is \$23,850 or less. The Code also allows senior citizens to register for non-credit or continuing education courses on a tuition-free basis, regardless of the level of income, so long as all conditions are met.

This Code does not provide for free textbooks and supplies.
