As a participating HEERF institution, Southwest Virginia Community College provides the following information:

Southwest Virginia Community College has signed and returned to the Department, the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under the Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

 - Student met the specified Expected Family Contribution (EFC) ceiling for the VCCS Cares Funding model at Southwest.
