

STUDENT EMERGENCY AID APPLICATION

Examples of qualifying emergency expenses include, but are not limited to:

- Food.
- Temporary Housing (rent/utilities).
- Medical Expenses/dental care/mental health-related expenses.
- Family Emergencies (visiting a sick family member, attending a funeral).
- Technology (replacement for a damaged/stolen item).
- Transportation (repairs to primary vehicle or temporary for-hire service).
- Childcare Expenses that are related to an emergency.
- Job Loss Contact the Financial Aid Office before submitting an Emergency Aid Application.

Eligibility Criteria:

- A. Student must be enrolled and meet satisfactory academic progress standards.
- **B.** Student must have submitted a FAFSA or, if not eligible for FAFSA, the state VASA application.
- C. Student must have submitted all institutional financial aid documentation.
- **D.** Student must demonstrate student financial need, as defined by the institution.
- **E.** Student must be enrolled during the term in which assistance is requested.
- **F.** Student must be a Virginia resident.
- G. Student must accept all offered financial aid prior to applying for emergency assistance funding.
