Shadowing/Observations - Applicant must also complete twelve (12) hours of observation in a Hospital Radiology Department. Observation must be documented by radiology personnel denoting date(s) and time(s). (NOT a clinic, urgent care, outpatient center, or doctor’s office).	Contact a HOSPITAL Radiology Department Manager to schedule. Please begin this process early as the hospitals have orientation and shot record requirements before you can begin observation hours. Contact your hospital of choice for details. Documentation form available https://sw.edu/wp-content/uploads/RAD-Student-Shadowing-Form-2017.pdf . Observation documentation must be received in the SWCC - Radiography Department – PO Box SVCC – Richlands, VA 24641 by January 15th.
